By the numbers: The Metropolitan Council estimates Hugo's population being over 17,000, a growth of over 150% since the 2000 Census population.

• What they're saying: The city-owned property on Egg Lake will be a centerpiece of the community's downtown, and residents will be drawn to the destination that will come out of a much needed restaurant or entertainment service.
