ICYMI - February Budget Forecast Released



What happened: Yesterday, the Minnesota Management and Budget <u>Office released its February budget forecast</u>, which gives lawmakers and the public an updated look at the state of the state's finances.

What they're saying: The 2024-25 biennium is now projected to end with a surplus of \$3.715 billion, an increase of \$1.324 billion compared to November projections.

• Yes, but: The higher revenue forecast throughout the FY 2024-27 planning horizon results in improvement to the structural budgetary balance, but spending is still projected to exceed revenue through FY 2027.


