DLI, NRA Advances Culinary Careers with Registered Apprentice Program



Did you know: Hospitality Minnesota Education Foundation is offering operators <u>a joint hospitality-focused Registered Apprenticeship Program</u> through a partnership with the National Restaurant Association and Minnesota's Department of Labor and Industry.

The bottom line: These programs help Minnesota's hospitality leaders combine on-the-job learning with related technical instruction to help them advance their careers.

- **Participants** earn a nationally recognized certificate and are determined as subject-matter experts in their field.
- **Companies** receive financial incentives for each apprentice they enroll and experience an average employee retention rate of 80%.

HMEF Launches Minnesota's Restaurant Ready Program



What is Restaurant Ready? Restaurant Ready is a National Restaurant Association (NRA) program dedicated to helping participants acquire the skills, discipline, and confidence necessary to start and stay employed in a hospitality career.

• How it works: Community-based organizations (CBOs) partner with the National Restaurant Association's Education Foundation (NRAEF) and their State Restaurant Association (SRAs) to provide pathway training in six work-ready competency areas defined by the hospitality industry.

Why it matters: Through partnerships with community-based organizations, such as <u>CAPI USA</u>, the program connects members to a more diverse talent pool including immigrants, refugees, workers with disabilities, community members with language barriers, and more.
