

### size, must pay at least \$11.13 per hour starting in 2025. • Training Wage Update: The training wage for workers under 20 years old increases to **\$9.08 per hour** for the first **90** days of employment.

• Minneapolis & St. Paul: These cities have higher minimum

wages that are not affected by this update.

• New Minimum Wage: All employers in Minnesota, regardless of

• **Provide employee notice:** Inform employees of any changes to their pay rate before they take effect.

• **Display updated poster:** Download and display the updated minimum wage poster in a visible location for employees.


