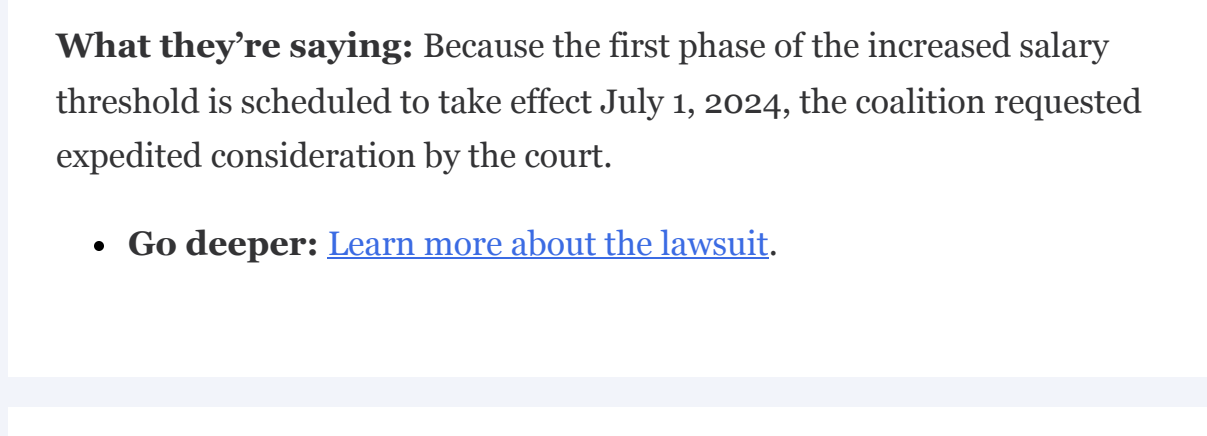

Restaurant Law Center Sues to Stop DOL Overtime Rule

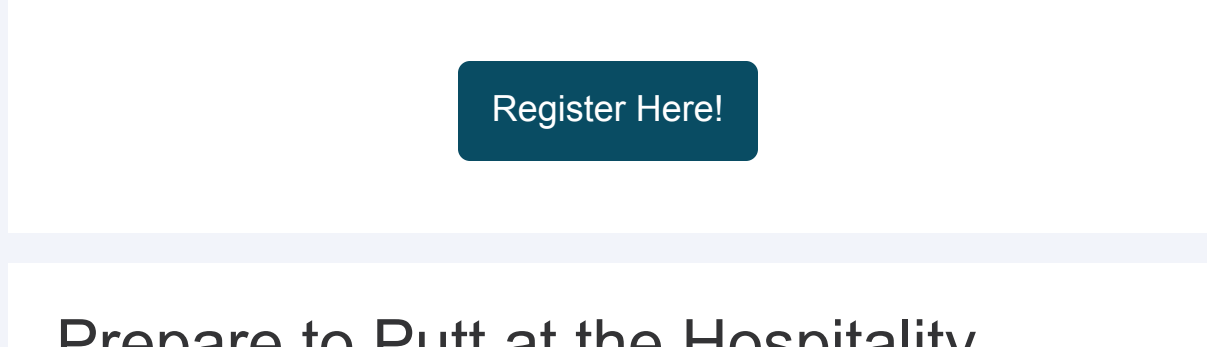


What happened: Last week, the Restaurant Law Center joined other business groups filed a lawsuit to stop the U.S. Department of Labor's 2024 Overtime Final 2024 Rule. The lawsuit seeks to vacate the 2024 Rule, arguing it imposes illegal and harmful regulations.

What they're saying: Because the first phase of the increased salary threshold is scheduled to take effect July 1, 2024, the coalition requested expedited consideration by the court.

AHLA To Host Webinar on DOL Overtime Rule Wednesday



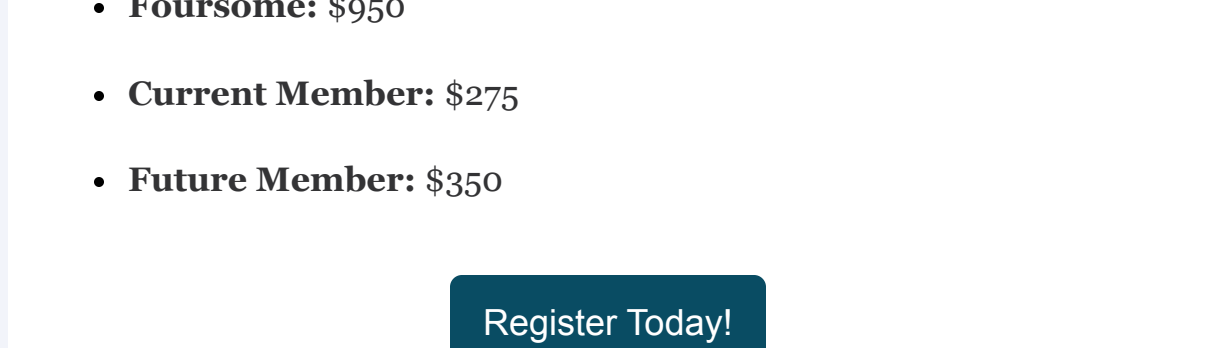

Why it matters: The [final rule](#) will increase the salary threshold to \$43,888 on July 1 and again to \$58,656 on Jan. 1, 2025.

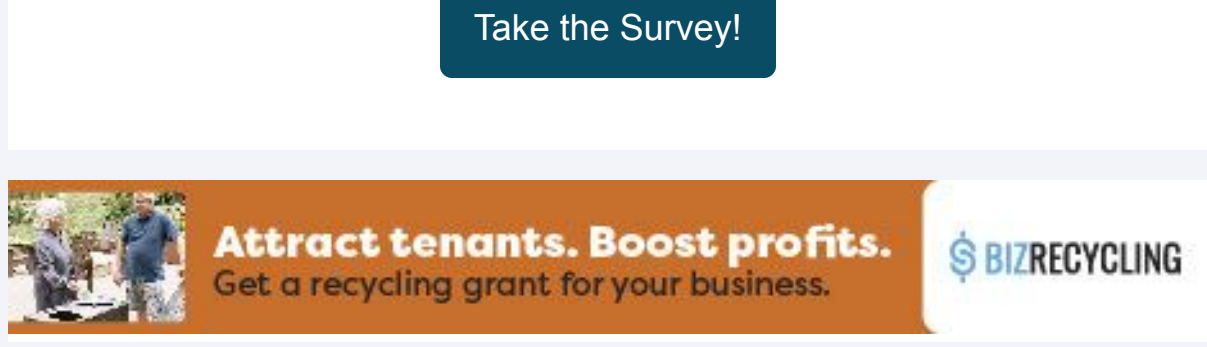

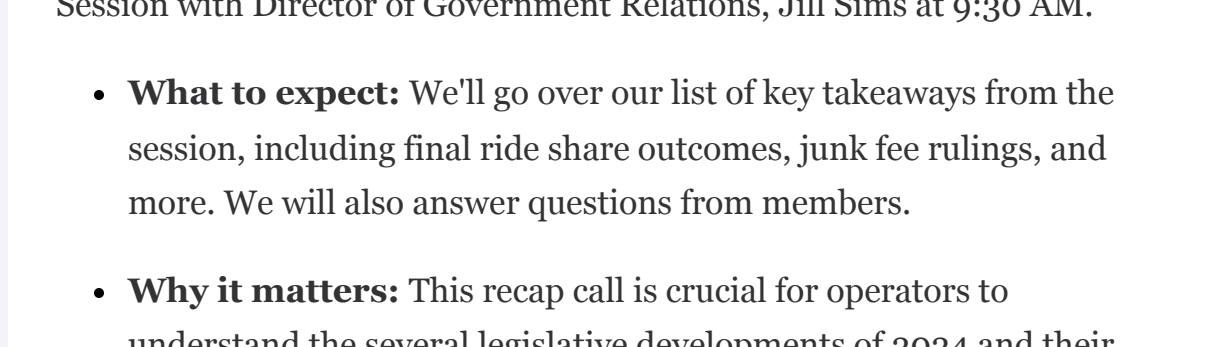
Take Minnesota Department of Agriculture's Produce Safety Survey

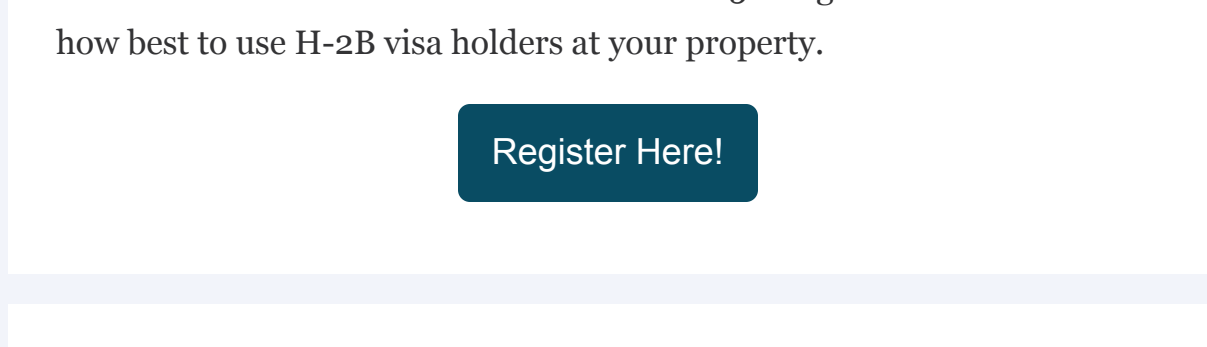

NRA to Host Child Labor Law Compliance Webinar June 18



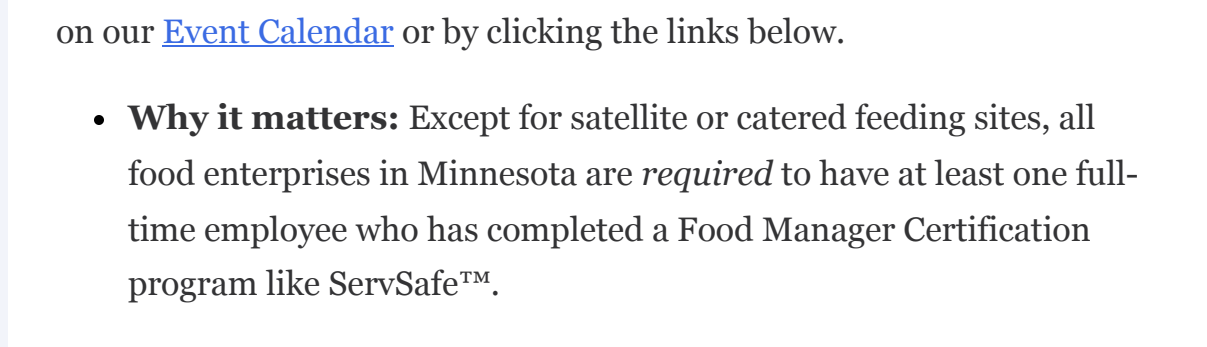
