DHS Reverses Guidance on

Latest Update

Earned Sick and Safe Time (ESST) laws and the Minnesota Paid Leave laws passed the Minnesota legislature. Our friends at Peters & <u>Kappenman</u> compiled a webpage on the updates passed for both programs. **ESST Provisions:**

• **Previous Provision:** Employers can request documentation when an employee uses ESST for more than *three* consecutive days. Paid Leave Provision: Minnesota Paid Leave laws, Minn. Stat. § 268B.14, subdivision 7 now specifies:
