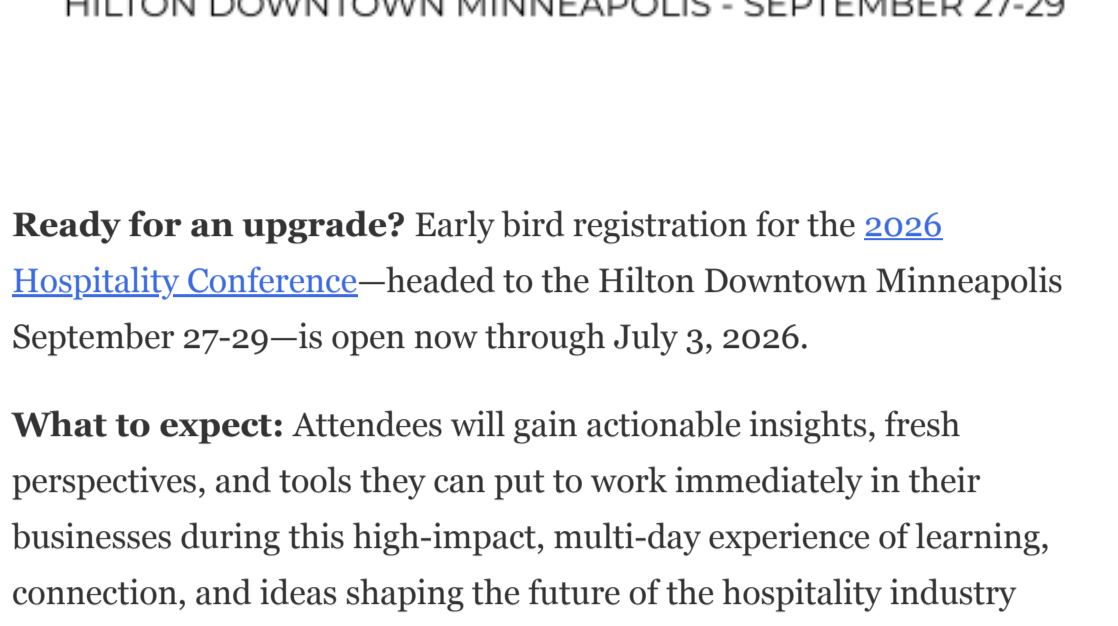

Federal Reserve Releases Analysis of Hospitality Conditions Survey

The big picture: Last week, the [Minneapolis Federal Reserve released an article](#) summarizing the results of our Spring 2026 Hospitality Conditions Survey.

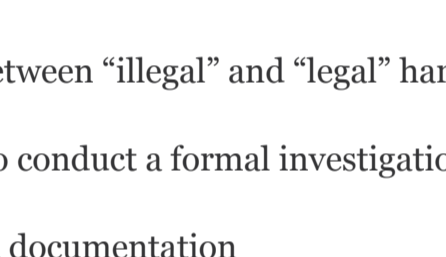
The results: Similar to [our previously reported key takeaways](#), the [Federal Reserve's article](#) highlighted a growing consensus of economic uncertainty and unease among hospitality operators.

- **What's driving uncertainty:** A majority of survey respondents reported lower revenue and profits throughout Q1 2026 than Q1 2025. According to the Federal Reserve, operators cite customers finding inflationary pressures and alarming concerns about the future as reason behind lower revenue and profits.
- **Other contributing factors:** The inability for retail pricing to keep up with a increase in wholesale costs have also contributed to half of respondents reporting pessimistic outlooks for the summer season.

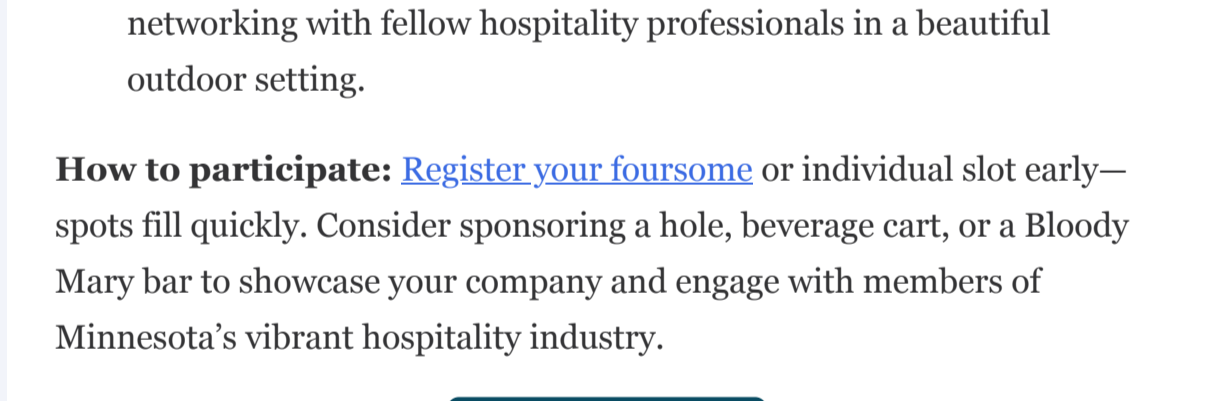

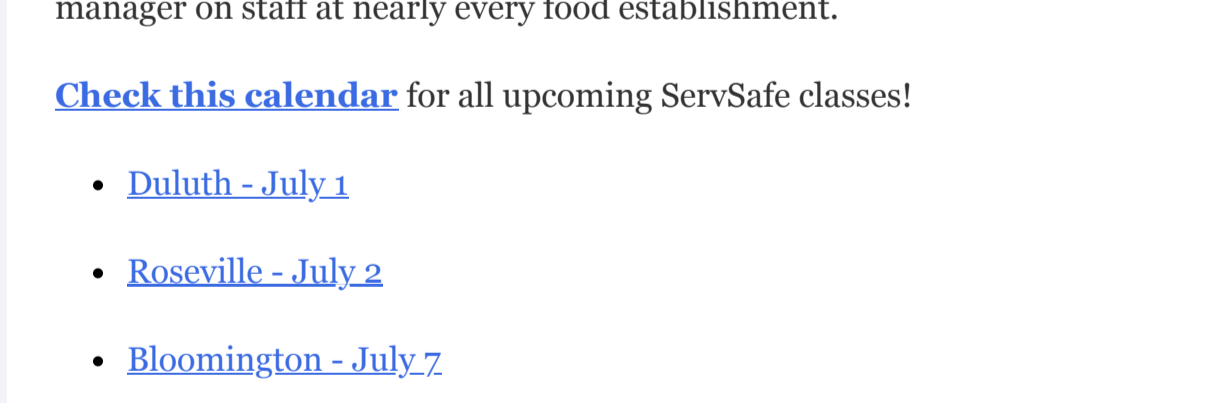
