

Hospitality Minnesota Education Foundation and Women Who Really Cook Sue Zelickson Scholarship Criteria

Academic Scholarship for Women Pursuing Higher Education in Culinary, Foodservice, or Hospitality Degrees

- 1. Student <u>must</u> be a resident of Minnesota.
- 2. Student **<u>must</u>** be a woman.
- Student <u>must</u> be pursuing a hospitality, foodservice, food science, or culinary arts degree at an accredited post-secondary institution. Full-time and part-time students are eligible (with a minimum of nine credit hours). This is limited to schools in Minnesota.
- 4. The Hospitality Minnesota Education Foundation (HMEF) and Women Who Really Cook (WWRC) Boards maintain the right to disapprove of the educational institution or program in which the student is enrolled.
- 5. Student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- 6. Student is required to submit an essay as outlined on the scholarship application.
- 7. Student must submit at least two letters of recommendation from persons other than family. We suggest both academic and employment references.
- 8. Students are required to submit official high school transcript.

Scholarship Denominations, Payment & Eligibility

- 1. WWRC Board and HMEF Board of Directors & Scholarship Committee will determine denominations of each scholarship given.
- 2. Scholarship awards will be limited to academic tuition and paid directly to the educational institution. The institution will contact HMEF requesting funds and verify that the student has completed his/her coursework satisfactorily.
- 3. Students may reapply for a scholarship if they demonstrate a 3.0 Grade Point Average and provide a letter of recommendation from a faculty member.
- 4. The WWRC and HMEF Board of Directors will make the determination of annual scholarships based on funds available and applicant pool.
- 5. Relatives of the members of the HMEF Board of Directors are ineligible.
- 6. Relatives of contributors are eligible, as are students who are also employed by contributing companies.
- 7. Relatives of the directors or officers of the MRA, MLA and MRCA Boards will be eligible, so long as they do not serve on the HMEF Board of Directors.
- 8. To ensure unbiased scholarship awards, a selection committee will use a standard application and scoring system based on academics, community involvement, hospitality experience, and a submitted essay.
