- Noteworthy bills that passed include legislation that slightly modifies Paid Leave and Earned Sick and Safe Time, increased appropriations for various workforce development initiatives, a slew of Licensing Fee Increases, and more.
- Noteworthy bills that did not pass include legislation that would have modified price transparency (junk fee) laws, the authorization of statewide social districts, a exemption for restaurant equiptment from state sales tax, and more.
