

Latest Paid Leave Updates from MN DEED





What happened: Last month, Minnesota Paid Leave concluded the initial draft comment period for rulemaking after an extensive public engagement process and has released a review of public commentary here.

• By the numbers: A series of listening sessions attracted more than 950 attendees across all sessions, and nearly 600 written comments were submitted on draft and potential rules. Minnesota Paid Leave is thankful to the stakeholders who took the time to participate in this process.

The bottom line: Your deep experience and unique perspectives will strengthen the rules and implementation of this important new undertaking, to deliver a Paid Leave program that works for all Minnesotans.

Office of Cannabis Management Seeks Feedback on Proposed Rules

MINNESOTA

What happened: The Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) has posted the <u>first draft of proposed rules (PDF)</u> for Minnesota's cannabis industry.

OFFICE OF CANNABIS MANAGEMENT

• Share your thoughts: OCM encourages people to submit feedback on the draft rules by <u>using this form</u>. The feedback window will be open from now through Aug. 30.

What they're saying: While these draft rules may be informative for potential operators and consumers, they may change as OCM goes through the formal rulemaking process.

• **Go deeper:** Later this year, OCM will publish in the State Register a notice of intent to adopt rules, which will prompt a 30-day formal comment period. Watch the OCM website for updates.
